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PRIMARY FOUR ENGLISH DRAMA EDUCATION

We believe that learning English should spark joy and curiosity. That is why since 2023, our Primary 4 students have taken part in an immersive drama education module designed to bring language off the page and onto the stage.

Supported step-by-step by our dedicated teachers, students begin their creative journey by reading model scripts and analyzing character backgrounds. This literacy foundation naturally transitions into deep, in-class discussions about the meaningful messages they wish to share with the community.

We utilize this drama framework as an opportunity for Values Education. By stepping into their characters' shoes, students actively explore, internalize, and express the twelve priority values and attitudes: Perseverance, Respect for Others, Responsibility, National Identity, Commitment, Integrity, Benevolence, Law-abidingness, Empathy, Diligence, Unity, and Filial Piety. Through this collaborative process, our young performers do not just memorize dialogue—they build character, develop social empathy, and learn to speak English with genuine pride and confidence.

Together, our young playwrights brainstorm original plots, write meaningful character dialogues, and work through rehearsals. Watching their growth throughout this module is incredibly inspiring. The process challenges them to step out of their comfort zones, but there is no greater reward than seeing our P4 students stand confidently on the school hall stage, delivering their lines in English with pride and a smile.
